Blood facts

Every two seconds someone in the U.S. needs blood.

More than 41,000 blood donations are needed every day.

A total of 30 million blood components are transfused each year in the U.S.

The blood type most often requested by hospitals is Type O.

More than 1.6 million people were diagnosed with cancer last year. Many of them will need blood, sometimes daily, during their chemotherapy treatment.

A single car accident victim can require as many as 100 pints of blood.

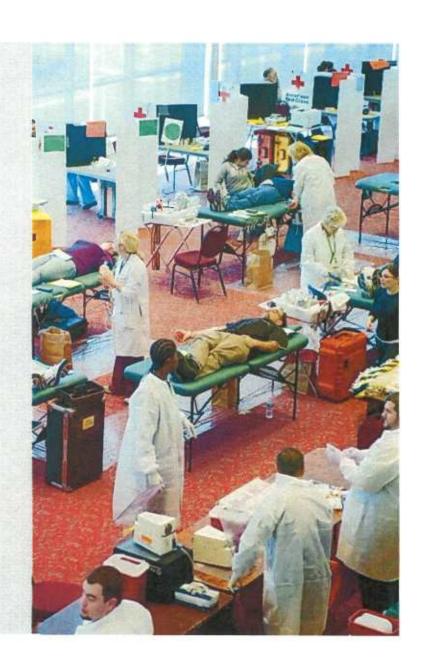

Blood Collection

...when there is a catastrophic accident and an 18-year old boy needs 36 blood transfusions, 13 plasma treatments and 14 operations to save his life.

...when a newborn needs blood transfusions every 3-4 weeks just to survive the first few months of life.
