Green Features of Transitions at Devens

Items you may already know:

- -Glazed loaded central hallway/corridor to catch the sun's warmth during colder temperatures outside
- -Storm Drainage to minimize impact on local facilities
- -Energy recovery system that reuses solar heated air from the corridor as well as warm exhaust air
- -All materials in the building are natural materials which enhance the indoor environment
- -All appliances used are Energy Star rated appliances, including the dishwashers and laundry machines.
- -Landscaping designed to conserve water and are also drought resistant
- -Still in the plans to install solar system panels to provide photovoltaic power.

Items you may NOT know:

- -Transitions at Devens Congregate facility accommodates 13 Single Mothers and their children; we've been in this building for a year now and have all ready served more than 70 families(this number is from 8/2010)!
- -Lighting is all energy efficient and either on motion sensor or a timer.
- -Two offices, meeting room as well as a central playroom
- -Laundry facilities are on a schedule and closed on Sundays.

All washing is done using cold water and our washers are high efficiency

-Individual thermostats for each room so that only rooms in use are being cooled/heated

Teaches smarter usage of thermostats for families

- -Staff inspects units 3x a week to ensure the following items
 - 1. Units are remaining clean with no fire hazards
 - 2. Unused rooms are not being cooled/heated; lights aren't being left on
 - 3. Windows are not open while Heat and/or AC is on
- -Encourage and practice good recycling habits
- -All Tubs/Shower systems are Temptrol-has a piston that continually equalizes the hot and cold water pressure as demands are elsewhere in the plumbing system. No "Shower Shock"
- -Water Heater is set at a level to conserve on heating while still providing warm/hot water for bathing needs
